The MPA Education and Training Committee is accepting proposals for presentations during the 2019 calendar year. Friday Forums are three-hour training sessions held in the Twin Cities that focus on clinical practice issues. Other Continuing Education programs may include full-day conferences and special programs. The audience includes a variety of mental health professionals/practitioners. We are especially looking for proposals related to the health care system, diversity, cultural competence and research/evidence-based clinical topics across the life span. Proposals from MPA members and nonmembers alike are welcome. Presenters receive a \$250 stipend for their Friday Forum program. **Review of proposals began July 1, 2018 and will continue until the 2019 program schedule is completed. Notification of acceptance will occur via email within three (3) months of submission.**
